WEST UNIVERISTY LITTLE LEAGUE 2024 PARENT GUIDE

The West University Little League is a 100% volunteer organization and operates on the premise that all parents will contribute their time and effort to their children's team and to the League in general, thereby creating a successful organization beneficial to everyone, especially our children.

PRE-SEASON LOGISTICS

- The League provides each player with a practice jersey, game jersey, hat and socks. Parents are responsible for providing pants and belt, and may want to check with the Team Manager if there is a color preference for either one. Parents are also responsible for providing gloves, bats, cleats and any other equipment or gear that their player may need for the season.
- Yard Signs: Available for purchase through Jan 31 using the QR code to the right. You may have already purchased a sign during registration; check your receipt or review the list provided at your Team Meeting if uncertain.



PRACTICES AND GAMES

- Practices begin the week of January 29. Your Manager will provide practice days and times. Games begin the week of February 12.
- Your child's team is counting on him/her to be there throughout the season. Plan vacations, camp and other out-of-town activities accordingly. Please provide your Team Manager with as much notice as possible of any absences.

CONCESSIONS DUTY

- Concessions will open at Main Campus on February 12. Concessions are one of our League's
 most important fundraisers, and the concession stand at Main Campus (aka, "The Dugout") is
 run entirely by volunteers.
- Each team will be assigned one or two shifts to work at The Dugout during the season. You can find your team's shift dates and times from your team's Concessions Chair or on our website www.westull.org/concessionstand.
- For each assigned shift, ONE parent for EACH player on the team must attend the shift, with the exception of twins on the same team (only one parent may attend on behalf of both players).
- Only Team Managers are exempt from concessions duty this year; otherwise, this duty is MANDATORY for all parents, including Assistant Managers.
- PARENTS are required to work; do not send a nanny, sibling or grandparent instead. If you are unable to work the assigned shift, it is your responsibility to find another parent to work your shift (including from another team).
- Auxiliary monitors the sign-in sheets for concessions shifts. Teams that fail to properly staff the concessions stand will lose a practice. In some cases, individuals may either lose their returning player status and/or automatically be placed on the waitlist for next year's registration.
- Shifts typically last 2.5 hours and are a really fun way to get to know the parents on your team!
- Everyone working in The Dugout must wear a hat.

OPENING CEREMONIES / CARNIVAL

- Opening Ceremonies will be held this year on February 24 at 11AM, with Carnival kicking off immediately after.
- Teams (Minor AA and below) will be assigned a shift or donation requirement for the Carnival. If you are unable to work the assigned shift, it is your responsibility to find another parent to work your shift (including from another team).

PHOTOS

• Team photos will be held on February 25 at Pershing Middle School. Time slots will be assigned closer to that date.

AUCTION

- Auction will be held on April 12 at Holman Draft Hall.
- The Auction is a fun and casual way to meet other parents, enjoy a great evening and participate in a chance to win great raffle prizes and auction items. It is also our primary fundraiser, so attendance is encouraged!
